Selection Criteria of Awards

Paper

1. Best Paper Award (6 awards under each sub-theme)
All selected papers will be ranked by each reviewer with 0 being the least and 10 being the highest. Papers ranked above 7 will be reviewed under each theme and sub-theme as potential papers for award under each category. The paper with the highest score will be entitled for this award. In case of a tie in the scores, the papers will be re-examined by a panel of juror and, the final decision of the panel will be considered as the winner of the award. There will be 6 awards to represent each theme. Any paper ranked below 7 by the reviewer/s will not be eligible for this award.
2. Overall Best Paper Award (1 Award)
The best selected papers in the above category (under each theme) will be reviewed by a panel of juror and, the final decision of the panel will be considered as the winner of the award. There is only one award in this category.
3. Outstanding Contributor of FARU 2019 Award (1 Award)
The overall performance of the participant within the conference will be reviewed for this award. Therefore, the participant **MUST** apply for this award by filling the "FARU Awards 2019 – Application Form". The overall performance will be judged based on the number of quality research papers, number of posters presented etc. at the FARU 2019 conference.

Poster

4. Best poster award (Bronze, Silver, Gold) – Academic track
All final posters (PDF) together with the content (mentioned under the Required Poster Format) will be reviewed by a panel of jurors. Each jury member will rank the posters and, the poster with the highest score will be entitled for this award. In case of a tie in the scores, the posters will be re-examined by a panel of juror and, the final decision of the panel will be considered as the winner of the award. There will be 3 awards - the highest scorer will receive a gold and the lowest a bronze. Any posters ranked below 7 by the reviewer/s will not be eligible for this award.
5. Best poster award (Bronze, Silver, Gold) – General track
The process is the same as the above: All final posters (PDF) together with the content (mentioned under the Required Poster Format) will be reviewed by a panel of jurors. Each jury member will rank the posters and, the poster with the highest score will be entitled for this award. In case of a tie in the scores, the posters will be re-examined by a panel of juror and, the final decision of the panel will be considered as the winner of the

award. There will be 3 awards - the highest scorer will receive a gold and the lowest a bronze. Any posters ranked below 7 by the reviewer/s will not be eligible for this award.

6. Best Student Poster award (1ward into four faculties)

The process is the same as the above two awards yet, the applicant eligible to this category should be the **first author and a student** either undergraduate or post graduate.

7. Outstanding contributor of FARU 2019 award

The overall performance of the participant within the conference will be reviewed for this award. Therefore, the participant **MUST** apply for this award by filling the “FARU Awards 2019 – Application Form”. The overall performance will be judged based on the number of quality research papers, number of posters presented etc. at the FARU 2019 conference.

8. Most Innovative Project Proposal Demo award

Only four teams will be selected to present at the conference after the abstract review process. These four teams are expected to present to a panel of juror for evaluation and to an open audience at the FARU Conference. Based on the team’s presentation and skill to answer questions from the open audience they will be ranked by the panel. The team with the highest score will be entitled for this prestigious award. There is only 1 award yet, all final team member will be awarded with a certificate of participation.
