Research Poster Display

Introduction - Research Poster Display

120 minute session

Poster sessions provide an opportunity to share research and practice-based work with participants under an academic and general track. Research posters are meant to share summarize information briefly and attractively to help publicize the generate discussion. Presenters have access to a display board to curate their work and must be present at the scheduled duration of the presentation. A jury will evaluate each poster and the best will be eligible for FARU Awards. The posters will also be displayed for the duration of the conference. The research poster submissions are open to researchers, academics, practitioners, industry and under-graduates.

Poster Tracks

Posters are a great way to tell others about research- based or project-based work conducted in a format that is informal and highly interactive. It also helps to connect with others with similar interests and share work through one-on-one discussions. With the intention of presenting a culmination of similar work and learning from each other, FARU 2019 conference will provide two poster tracks:

I. Academic Poster Track

This track will present 'research-based work' conducted as individual or group. The posters can highlight theory or conceptual frame work conducted in a more academic setting.

II. General Poster Track

This track will present 'project- based work' conducted as individual or group. The posters can highlight practitioner research undertaken in a more practical context or industry biased.

Submission of Abstracts

Abstracts of 250-300 words are invited to be submitted for blind review. Do not include the author details with the abstract but fill in the abstract submission form (For the link please refer the website, 'Call for Papers' page <Submission of Abstracts <Important links < DOWNLOAD - Abstract submission form). Once the abstract is submitted through the Conference Management System and via e mail, an "Identification Number starting with **PO_**" will be allocated for each submission. Selected authors will be invited to submit and/or present after a further review.

Please note that the abstracts should describe original research and should NOT include tables, charts, or graphs in your abstract submission. The abstract should include the title, summarized purpose of the research, methodology, findings, and implications.

Final Poster Submissions

After the notification of the reviewed abstract for poster presentations the final posters need to be submitted. Required content and the composition of the final poster is given below. The final posters will be double-blind reviewed by a panel of jurors in the Scientific Committee. Final poster for blind review should be submitted in PDF format.

After the notification of the final poster (round two), the authors are expected to submit a printed poster (physical poster to the FARU Office). In addition, please forward a PDF version of the poster and the “conference registration form” to this email address faru@uom.lk under the subject of <Final Poster submission>. The final print ready poster should be composed according to the required Poster format.

Poster Content

The Posters can report research that is in-progress or completed, yet we expect most posters to represent work completed or to present initial findings. There are no restrictions on the types of studies that can be presented as long as its based on the theme of the conference.

A good poster should introduce the topic, research questions or goals, methods, and/or best practices, along with what was accomplished and what was learned. It may include the following:

- Poster title.
- Images to illustrate the points.
- Brief text carefully edited without spelling errors.

*The test of a good poster is to be able read in 60 seconds and to understand the main points.
